At the Lyme Central school budget vote on May 16, 2005, there will be a question on the ballot about funding for the Lyme Free Library of Chaumont. Voting YES will provide the library with \$5,000 in additional annual funding for a total of \$19,500.

The total cost to taxpayers will increase by approximately \$2.00 annually (based on \$50,000 assessed property value).

Voting YES for library funding will not take any funds away from the schools nor does it affect school funding in any way.

\$5,000 in additional funding will cost each taxpayer 4 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value (\$2.00 for a \$50,000 assessment).
